New in 6.d: await no longer blocks a thread while waiting. This speeds things up and avoids deadlocks. Try it out today with Rakudo compiler and **v6.d.PREVIEW** pragma:

use v6.d.PREVIEW; await ^10 .map: { start await ^25 .map: { start await Promise.in: 1 } } say "It took \$(now - ENTER now) seconds to run";
