

New in 6.d: smarter \$*ARGFILES in sub MAIN

Inside **sub MAIN**, **\$*ARGFILES** is set to read from **\$*IN**, so you are free to use routines like **slurp()**, **words()**, **lines()**, etc. without the arguments given to **MAIN** interfering by being treated as filenames. In the rare case that you do want the old behaviour, you can still get it by setting up an **I0::CatHandle** with **@*ARGS**.
