New in 6.d: smarter \$*ARGFILES in sub MAIN

Inside **sub** MAIN, **\$*ARGFILES** is set to read from **\$*IN**, so you are free to use routines like **slurp()**, **words()**, **lines()**, etc. without the arguments given to MAIN interfering by being treated as filenames. In the rare case that you do want the old behaviour, you can still get it by setting up an **IO::CatHandle** with **@*ARGS**.

use v6.d.PREVIEW;
sub MAIN($separator) {
    say "Enter words to separate with `$separator`:";
    say "Result is: ", words.join: " $separator "
}
```

```
$ perl6 script.p6 et
Enter words to separate with `et`:
un deux
trois
Result is: un et deux et trois
```
